Our family farming heritage, love of the Pacific Northwest and an appreciation for great Pinot noir led us to Oregon's wine industry. In the summer of 2005 we purchased a quarter section of harvested forestland and established Fairsing Vineyard. With the assistance of Oregon's collegial winegrowing community, we began the development of the vineyard. By October of 2006, eighteen acres were successfully planted and trellised. Vineyard development continued at roughly five acres per year to the current thirty-eight acres of

Pinot noir and two acres of Chardonnay.

We are often asked "why a vineyard in Oregon?" The long and the short of our answer is that we feel Oregon Pinot noir is world class, we appreciate the rewards and challenges of wine growing and the camaraderie of the supportive wine community. And really, Oregon rain beats the heat or cold.



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
