The Vintage

Our 2014 Estate Pinot Noir is the product of one of the warmest growing seasons on record in the Willamette Valley.

We observed bud break April 11 followed by beautiful gentle rains throughout April and May. Bloom occurred in early June, followed by véraison in early August.

This 2014 Estate Pinot Noir was harvested September 16, 2014. Our fruit was in immaculate condition at harvest with higher than expected yields.

The Vineyard

Fairsing Vineyard is managed sustainably in Oregon's Yamhill-Carlton American Viticulture Area (AVA) with 38 acres of Pinot noir and two acres of Chardonnay in production.

Our vineyard is nestled inside an 80-acre Certified Family Forest distinguished by biodiversity, varied topography, and panoramic views of the Northern Willamette Valley.

We feel that our exquisite site in conjunction with our impeccable farming practices create every possibility for consistently beautiful wines. Our 2014 Fairsing Vineyard Pinot Noir represents our entire vineyard and contains selections Dijon 777, 115 and Pommard and Wadensvil.

Tasting Notes

Garnett in color with warm scents of earth and sweet blackberry this Pinot Noir is well-balanced and compelling.

The warm dark fruits overlaid with toasty vanilla sing on the palate. The pleasing linear entry yields to a long clean finish.

This wine may be enjoyed now or will cellar well for many years.
